What Do I Need To Bring

Monday - Thursday: Please bring a packed lunch, including a drink and several snacks for the day (we will have two snack times throughout the day on top of lunch). Friday's are pizza day but please bring snacks for those days as well. A packed lunch on Friday is optional.

Summer Camp Weekly Craft 2022:

Week of:

5/30/22:

- Pontoon Boats: Make "pontoon" boats out of cardboard boxes. (balloons and shoe boxes, paint)
- Leis (flower print outs, straws, string)
- Pineapple with handprint top (construction paper, pain)

6/6/22:

- Paper Plate Earth (paper plate)
- 3 D Eiffel Tower (print out)
- Japanese Lantern Craft (construction paper and string)
- Pick a flag (construction paper)
- Peru Wind Instrument (paper or cardboard and straws)

6/13/22:

- Make slime (Elmer's glue, borax, water, and food coloring)
- Make a volcano (empty water bottles, newspaper, water and glue. Baking soda then food coloring and vinegar)
- Water cycle paper plate (paper plate 3 sections, condensation; cotton balls, precipitation; draw rain, evaporation; water (lake))

6/20/22:

- Draw a farm animal that starts with the first letter of your name (construction paper, scissors, crayons)
- Handprint horse (construction paper, markers, scissors)
- Sheep (cotton balls, construction paper, googly eyes)
- T is for tractor (draw a T on a piece of paper and draw a tractor)

6/27/22:

- Paper airplane spaceship
- Make your own planet
- UFO Spaceship (two paper plates stapled together and put aluminum foil over it and decorate)

7/11/22:

- Plastic bag jellyfish (plastic bags, pompoms, rubber band, googly eyes, scissors)
- Sea shell paper plate (cut paper plate into a shell shape and decorate it)
- Shark teeth (cut out a triangle for the sharks (construction paper) head
- Foil fish (cut out a fish shape then cover it in foil and decorate the fish)

7/18/22:

- Make a structure (toothpicks and marshmallows)
- Dream house (make your dream house with construction paper, popsicle sticks, crayons)
- Make a tool box (cut a tool box out of construction paper and draw what they would want/ need in their own tool box)
- Car painting (construction paper) roll matchbox cars around in paint to make a design)

7/25/22:

- Fingerprint balloons (construction paper, markers, paint)
- Cotton candy (cut out cotton candy and paint to make their own cotton candy)
- Juggle balls (balloons and painters tape)
- Clown tie (string and construction paper)

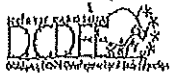
