Friday Pizza: \$5 each week which can be paid weekly or monthly

Each child will have a pouch kept at the school for extra field trip money (food, drink, etc.) You may deposit money at any time. This money will be carried by the summer camp staff at all times.

WHAT DO I NEED TO SEND?

Daily / Weekly Needs

Monday - Thursday:

- Please send a packed lunch and refillable water bottle daily
- Children should wear closed-toed shoes
- Bring 2 snacks for the day (we will have two scheduled snack times each day on top of lunch)

Friday:

- On Fridays, pizza is provided for lunch but please bring snacks for that day as well. (If your child does not like pizza, they are welcome to bring a packed lunch)
- Pizza is \$5 per child, per week.

Sunscreen:

- We ask for each child to donate at least two bottles of spray sunscreen (SPF 50 or higher). If your child needs a particular sunscreen, please label it with their first and last name before giving it to a counselor.
- There is a permission form and medical release form that you must fill out so that we may apply sunscreen as needed.

Extra Money:

- Extra money for field trips (extra snacks, souvenirs, etc.) should be labeled and given to a counselor for your student's money pouch. This money will stay with a counselor at all times.

General:

- On Friday's we will have Water and Bike Day. Students should bring a change of clothes, bathing suit (optional), water shoes and a towel. Students are welcome to bring their bikes / scooters to ride on the track.
- No electronics allowed at summer camp.

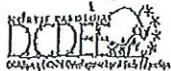

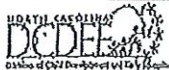
